God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change; courage to change the things I can; and wisdom to know the difference.

I've shared that I'm an addict. Are there any other addicts present? Thank you for being here. If you are seeking recovery you are in the right place.

Crystal Meth Anonymous is a fellowship of men and women who share their experience strength and hope with each other so that they may solve their common problem and help others to recover from addiction to crystal meth and all other mind-altering substances.

- ❖ The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop using.
- ❖ There are no dues or fees for CMA membership; we are self-supporting through our own contributions.
- ❖ CMA is not allied with any sect, denomination, politics, organization or institution; does not wish to engage in any controversy; and neither endorses nor opposes any causes.
- ❖ Our primary purpose is to live free of active addiction and carry that message to the addict who still suffers.

At this time, I would ask everyone to turn off any cell phones or pagers. Please refrain from texting at this meeting. Thank you.

In keeping with the second tradition, changes to the air conditioners, lights, or windows must be determined by a group conscience.

The format of this meeting is as follows:

- ❖ We will begin with a selected reading;
- ❖ Then our speaker will share his/her experience, strength and hope for 20-25 minutes;
- ❖ That is followed by a secretary's break with the sharing of clean time for those counting days.
- ❖ We will then open up the meeting to everyone for sharing.
- ❖ At 8:45 [8:40]* we will call for a "burning desire."
- ❖ If there are no burning desires, we will continue sharing until 9:00pm [8:45pm]*.
- ❖ *[Tonight we have a business meeting after the meeting so if you wish to stay, please stay and if you need to leave, please leave quickly – you may wait for us in the front of the building for fellowship].**

We will now go to a show of hands for beginners counting days until [*Chair splits remaining time between beginner's sharing and general sharing until 8:45*] [*8:40*]

AFTER HALF THE REMAINING TIME:

We will now open the meeting up to everyone, but beginners are encouraged to continue sharing.

AT 8:45pm [*8:40pm*]*

Now is the time we call for a "burning desire." This is the time of the meeting we reserve for those who feel that, if they do not get a chance to share, they may use, hurt themselves or hurt someone else. Are there any burning desires?

IF THERE ARE NO BURNING DESIRES:

Then we can continue sharing from the floor until 9:00pm [*8:45pm*]*
